Screening is conducted for students in
grade 9

Letters are sent to parents prior
to screening and parents can opt their
child out of the screening

Screening entails an SOS video shown
to students during an academic class
and students' emotional states are
screened. This will prompt follow up
actions by the school.

After every screening, a team will
contact parents to discuss important
issues, provide resources and outline
next steps.
